

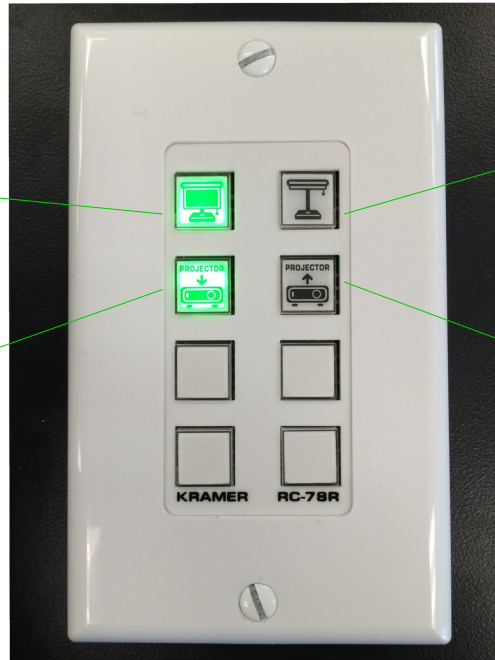
Room 2602 Technology

This document will outline how to use the technology in Room 2602.

1 Screens & Projectors

Click once to bring down all of the screens

Click once to turn on all of the projectors



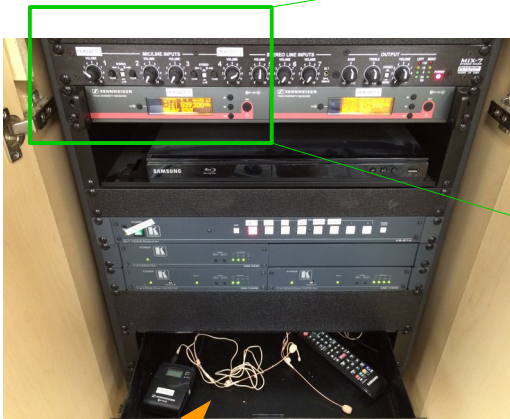
Click once to bring up all of the screens

Click once to turn off all of the projectors

Note: This room is not like other projectors where you have to press the power button twice to turn them off.
ONLY CLICK IT ONCE

2 Headsets

When you open the cabinet doors on the left side of the podium, you will see the technology shown in the images below. In the drawer, you will find 2 headsets. The volume control for these headsets is demonstrated in the green box below.



Headsets in the drawer

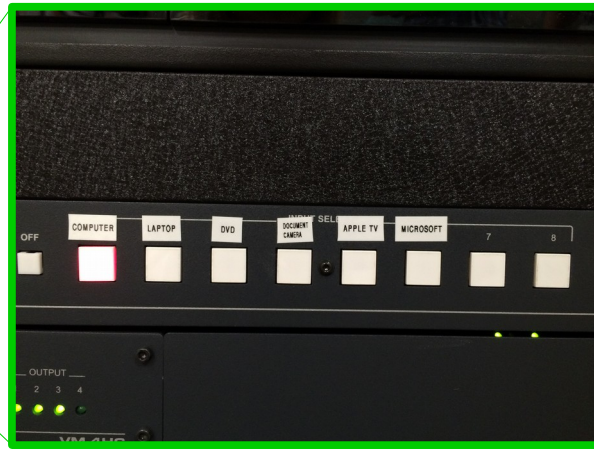

3 Displaying Other Devices

In the cabinet, you will find the buttons to switch between devices such as a Laptop, DVD, Apple TV, and Microsoft (wirelessly connect to devices such as Android and PC).



Note: To connect a USB stick, use the ports in the monitor

Press the associated button to switch between devices

4 Connecting a Laptop

Once you press the button associated with the device you wish to connect, you will need to connect the device. For example, if you are connecting a laptop, you will need to connect it using the labelled HDMI cord on the podium.

Note: If you do not have an HDMI port on your laptop, you will need an adapter

The technology will automatically adjust to the screen resolution of the connected device. **Leave the screen resolution settings as they are.**

5 Room's Light Controls

For optimal viewing of the screens in the room, use the following light switch configuration:
